MINUTES

1. To receive and approve apologies for absence - None
2. Declarations of interest in any matter – being prejudicial or personal – None
3. To carry out an inspection of the Graveyard

An inspection of the Graveyard was carried out by the Committee and the following actions agreed:

- 3.1 Church Walk – over hanging branches to be cut back. Replacement hedgerow whips to be planted in section where dead trees were removed. Weeds along walls to be treated/removed.
- 3.2 Elders to be removed where growing in burial plots. Suckers to be removed from the base of trees.
- 3.3 Reserve and RIP stones to be edged.
- 3.4 Monuments in the middle of the plot on two burial. These should be placed at the head of the burial plot.
- 3.5 Rose on plot 12A exceeds the height stated in the regulations.
- 3.6 Plots 12a D and 12a H to be turfed. The end of plot 15C needed to be turf to the correct length.
- 3.7 Planting along the boundary with Woodpecker Close needed to be cut back by 1 metre and reshaped.
- 3.8 Garden of Remembrance – sections of the dwarf foliage between the memorial stones were not growing. The foliage should be replaced with creeping thyme.
- 3.9 Path from New Road and the Churchyard required edging.
- 3.10 Consult with the Church with regard to the area of Churchyard overgrown with ivy and moss and the condition of the wall by New Road.
